Scripture: | Kings 19:11-13 & Jn. 10:27, et al

INTRODUCTION:

Read: 1 Kings 19:11-13

¹¹ The LORD said, "Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the LORD, for the LORD is about to pass by." Then a great and powerful wind tore the mountains apart and shattered the rocks before the LORD, but the LORD was not in the wind. After the wind there was an earthquake, but the LORD was not in the earthquake. ¹² After the earthquake came a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire. And after the fire came a gentle whisper [a still, small voice -**KJV**]. ¹³ When Elijah heard it, he pulled his cloak over his face and went out and stood at the mouth of the cave.

A. *Illustration*. Gary Henecke in our pre-marital counseling:

You will be so in love with each other, more than anyone else, so much that even in a crowded, noise-filled room, you can recognize the sound of your mate's voice. You are tuned in to that voice!

Dr. David Gibbs, Founder of the Christian Law Association, said that the question Christians should ask is not if God will give me direction.

The question we should be asking is

The focus of the question is not "what does God do," but rather, what are we doing?
